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## Monthly Report on the Corporate Goods Price Index

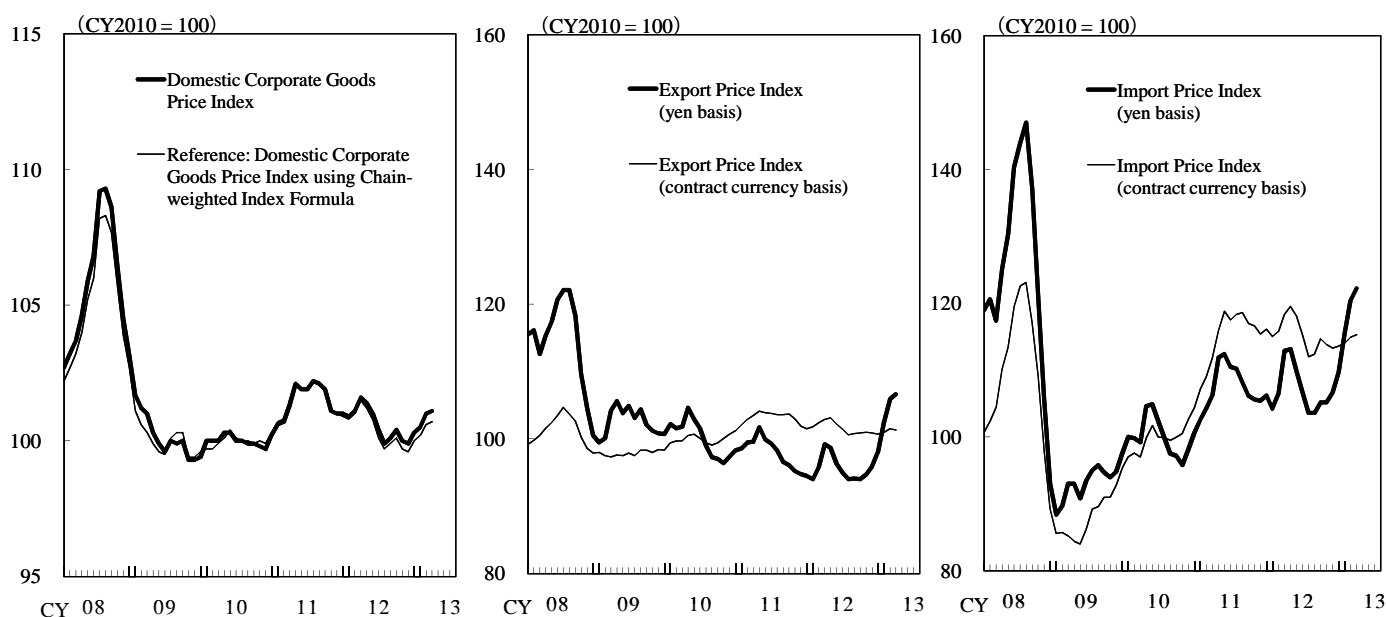
( Preliminary Figures for March 2013 )

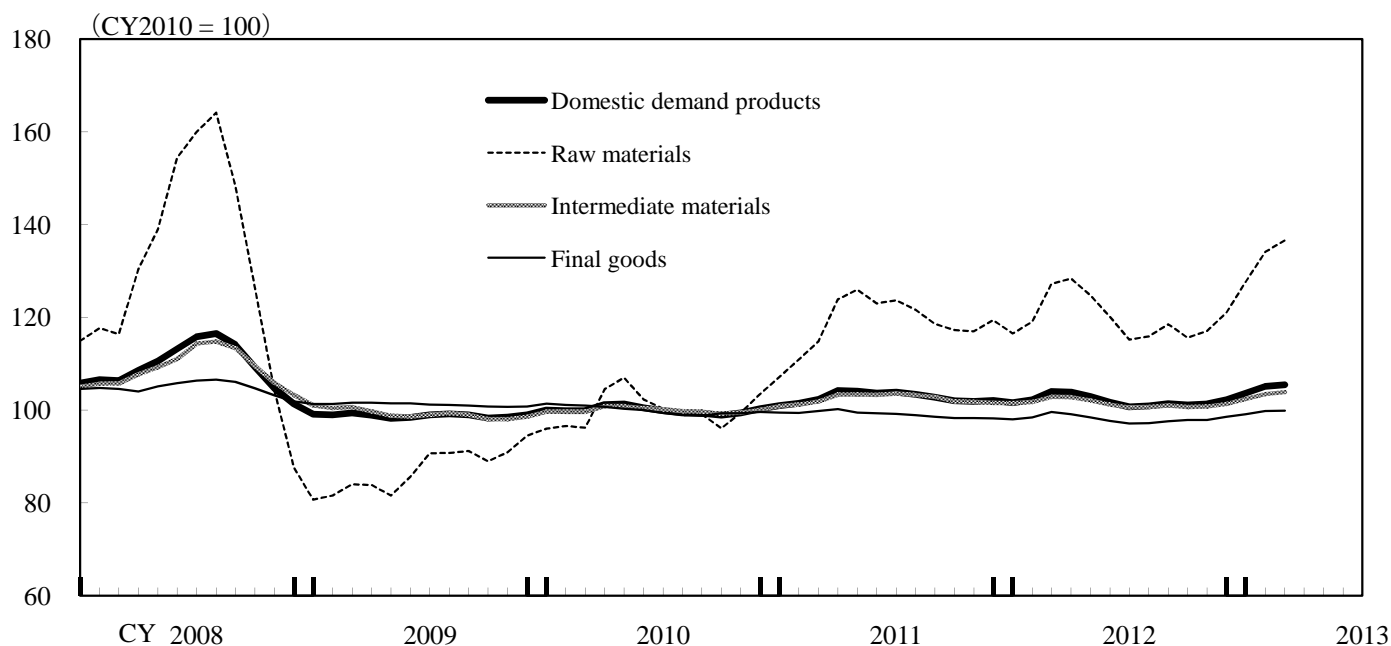
