Reinforcement Work on the Bank's Head Office Building

The Bank has decided to carry out seismic reinforcement work on the Main Building.

This building is the oldest part of the Head Office buildings in Tokyo, and an Important Cultural

Property constructed in 1896.

The base isolation work is scheduled to take place from October 2016 through June 2019.

During this period, the area around and under the Main Building will be excavated, and temporary

enclosures will be constructed on the premises.

Consequently, the West Entrance of the Main Building will be closed and the parking

area in the front yard of the building will be unavailable during the above period. 1,2

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
