Completion of Reinforcement Work on the Main Building of the Bank of Japan's Head Office Building

The seismic reinforcement work on the Main Building of the Bank of Japan's Head Office in Tokyo, which began in October 2016, was completed by the end of June 2019, as scheduled. Constructed in 1896, the building is the oldest part of the Head Office buildings and is designated an Important Cultural Property.

The Bank will proceed with remaining necessary work, such as interior finishing, and will resume in-house tours of the Main Building depending on the progress of this work. The Bank plans to resume part of the in-house tours around August 2019, and full tours around spring 2020. Details will be announced later.
