

Entry Procedures

All visitors to the Bank's Head Office, excluding those to the banking hall counters, the Information Room, and the Currency Museum, are required to present a valid photo identification (hereafter "photo ID") at one of the Reception areas, which are located at the North Entrance, the East Entrance, and the Annex Building entrance, whether they have an appointment or not (please note that visitors may not be permitted to enter the Bank without an appointment). Acceptable IDs include the following: passport; driver's license; employee or student photo ID; Basic Resident Registration Card with a photo; disability certificate; credit card with a photo; or "taspo," an age verification card for purchasing cigarettes from vending machines, issued after confirming that the holder is 20 or above. Except for visitors to the banking hall counters, the Information Room, and the Currency Museum, visitors without a valid photo ID will not be permitted to enter the Head Office.

Note that the Bank's entrances are open only on weekdays, during the following hours.

North Entrance: 6:30 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

East Entrance: 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

South Entrance: 8:50 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The Annex Building entrance: 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

—The West Entrance is open only for visitors participating in the Bank's in-house tour, for which you are kindly requested to make reservations in advance. Entry procedures for the tour participants will be provided separately upon reservation.
