The Bank of Japan has launched on its website "BOJ from Home," a free online tour that offers a 3-D/virtual reality (VR) viewing experience as you explore the tour route of the Bank's Head Office.

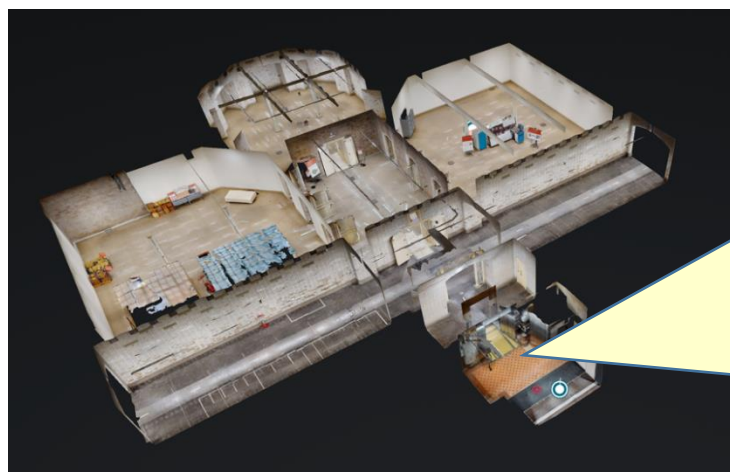

- The tour lets you explore the Main Building, an Important Cultural Property, as you like; at any time, from anywhere. The Main Building is the work of TATSUNO Kingo (1854-1919), a well-known architect of the day.
- You can view the Main Building's interior in 3-D on any PC or mobile device and enjoy an immersive virtual reality experience with VR goggles or glasses.



The Main Building, completed in 1896, was the first full-scale Western-style building designed by a Japanese architect. You can explore the underground vault and the old banking hall in 3-D and VR.



Click on the location of your choice on the 3-D model of the building. You will be able to take a virtual walk into the area and explore what's inside (pictured below is the 25-ton vault door).
