Study Group on Risk-Free Reference Rates Minutes for the November 30, 2016 Meeting 4:30 – 5:15 PM

(Meeting Room in the Bank of Japan)

- 1. Members approved the minutes of the October 28, 2016 meeting. They also approved the publication of the minutes on the Bank of Japan's web site.
- 2. The Secretariat provided an update on recent developments of international discussions about risk-free reference rates.
- 3. Members discussed the draft of "the Report on the Identification of a Japanese Yen Risk-Free Rate" presented by the Secretariat. Some members appreciated that as a result of additional discussions since June 2016, they could confirm that the market depth and variety of participants had been maintained in the uncollateralized call market even after the introduction of "Quantitative and Qualitative Monetary Easing with a Negative Interest Rate". Members therefore agreed to identify the uncollateralized overnight call rate as the JPY risk-free rate. The report was scheduled to be published by the end of the year.
- 4. The Study Group also discussed the work plan for 2017 and decided to discuss the details of the reforms to OIS market conventions suggested in the public consultation paper published in March 2016 and the means other than the suggested reforms including end-user outreach to promote the use of the risk-free rate. The Study Group will also continue to follow developments of the effort to create a new GC repo benchmark as such effort is important for enhancing transparency of the repo market.
- 5. The Chair announced that members would discuss the measure to expand the use of the risk-free rate in 2017.
