Changes in Items in "Sources of Changes in Current Account Balances at the Bank of Japan and Market Operations"

The Bank of Japan will change the formats of "Sources of Changes in Current Account Balances at the Bank of Japan and Market Operations" and discontinue updating the relevant time-series data. The details are as follows.

1. Daily data

The item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" will be deleted from "BOJ Loans and Market Operations."

Note: The item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" will be deleted, beginning with the data for July 1, 2026.

2. Monthly data (final figures)

The item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" will be deleted from "BOJ Loans and Market Operations." Additionally, the items "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" and "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth (million U.S. dollars)" will be deleted from "Amount outstanding."

Note: The item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" and "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth (million U.S. dollars)" will be deleted, beginning with the data for July 2027, when the data for "Previous year" become unavailable. However, the item of the abolished operations will be released in the March 2028 data, which include the data for entire fiscal 2026.

3. Time-series data

Updating the data of the item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for economic growth" under "BOJ Loans and Market Operations" and "Outstanding" will be discontinued.

Note: The item "Fund-provisioning measure to support strengthening the foundations for

economic growth" will no longer be updated from the July 2026 data.
